



Message from the Chairman



Dear Stakeholders,

The year 2024 stood out as a period in which global economic balances were reshaped, bringing both uncertainties and new opportunities to the fore. The world economy sought direction within the framework of geopolitical tensions, the critical phase of energy transition, and the financial discipline applied in monetary policies. Digital transformation, green economy approaches based on environmental sustainability, and rapidly developing artificial intelligence technologies formed the cornerstones of a new growth model. The Turkish economy also experienced a unique process shaped by

its internal dynamics in the shadow of these global developments. The fight against inflation, steps toward simplifying monetary policy, and strategic moves to reshape fiscal discipline have laid an important foundation for increasing predictability in the business world. At the same time, policies aimed at diversifying exports, increasing productivity in manufacturing, and protecting employment have been among the factors supporting the economy's resilient structure.

In such a multidimensional and volatile economic environment, we at Polat have continued to shape our strategy according to today's dynamics. Our company, which set out 70 years ago with great effort and determination, has today transformed into a strong ecosystem operating in different sectors and advancing with the goal of becoming one of the leading companies in Türkiye and the world. As always, this long journey has been underpinned by honesty, hard work, and a people-oriented management approach.

We began our corporate transformation process in 2020 and have progressed with determination, focusing on our goal of establishing the desired structure. With this new era, we are not only increasing our operational efficiency but also transforming our corporate culture into a more participatory and sustainable structure. With our PolatOne perspective, we bring our competencies together in harmony with a shared vision, allowing us to focus on our strategic goals more clearly and powerfully. We believe that each individual's contribution determines the success of the whole; we wholeheartedly believe that the power born from this unity will add value not only to Polat but also to our industry and our country.

In the energy sector, we contribute to a sustainable future through our renewable energy projects with Polat Energy. With a total installed capacity of 806 MWm, we account for approximately 6% of Türkiye's wind energy capacity. We are also making significant investments in energy storage. At Göktepe WPP, we

have reached an agreement with Rolls-Royce Solutions GmbH for Türkiye's largest battery energy storage system project.

INDUSTRY AND TECHNOLOGY

We continue to take important steps on the international stage and make global investments in renewable energy projects. We made our first investment in the field of solar energy in Hungary. We completed Lumen Park Szolnok, one of the largest new generation solar power plants in Central and Eastern Europe and set a new benchmark for sustainable finance models with Lumen Park Szászberek. With our investment in the Mezőtúr region, we also launched our first project focused entirely on the free market. In Berlin, we signed a letter of intent with ENERCON and is Enerii for new wind investments totaling 2,500 MW. Furthermore, we obtained our first battery storage license to make energy production in Türkiye more balanced and are expanding our production capacity by increasing our wind and solar energy investments.

Through all these investments, we generate employment opportunities and contributing to regional development by collaborating with local communities. We continue to make a tangible and lasting impact in the regions where we operate through our education and social development-focused projects. With our belief in the power of education, we continue to raise awareness among children and teachers about clean energy for a more conscious future through our "Green Light for the Future" social responsibility project.

We completed our award-winning mixed-use project, the LEED certified Duna Pearl, with Polat Gayrimenkul in Budapest, our first project in the city, with an investment value of 110 million euros, consisting of residences, hotels, and stores. We have also completed the first phase of City Pearl, another major project in Hungary with a total investment of 683 million euros and have begun deliveries. We will make the second phase deliveries in 2025. In addition, we have taken the first step for our Seven Pearl project, which will be located in the Elisabethváros district, one of

Budapest's most popular areas, with an investment of approximately 90 million euros. We have also completed the renovation and office building construction of the Ankara Embassy as of 2024.

In our projects in Türkiye, we have connected approximately 60% of our building stock in Piyalepaşa İstanbul Premium and around 30% of our apartments in Polat Levent Exclusive with their owners. In addition to our deep-rooted experience in real estate and energy, we are making investments aimed at contributing to our country in the technology and industrial sectors as well. Our company Poloptech, established with 100% national capital, contributes to Türkiye's space activities while manufacturing precision optical products for various sectors. In cooperation with TÜBİTAK UZAY, we are working on the development of a wide-angle camera system for Türkiye's Moon Mission. We have made an investment of approximately \$10 million within the scope of this project. Furthermore, under the Poltech umbrella, we are active in areas such as valuable paper production and integrated system solutions.

We continued to establish strong partnerships aimed at strengthening commercial relations this year with our company ALX Polat Foreign Trade, the official representative of the Hungarian Export Promotion Agency HEPA responsible for Türkiye and Greece. Between 2016 and 2024, we played an active role in increasing the trade volume between Hungary and Türkiye by 66% to \$4.60 billion and the trade volume between Hungary and Greece by over 100% to \$1.1 billion.

In our 70th year, we look to the future with hope, drawing strength from our past, and we continue to produce and create value for our country and our world. I sincerely thank our valued colleagues, business partners, and stakeholders who walk with us on this journey that shapes the future.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE



Investing in Türkiye's key sectors, namely real estate, energy, industry, and technology, Polat Holding continues to create added value for the country's economy through the synergy created with its group companies.

The most prestigious real estate projects bear the "Polat" signature

Under the Real Estate Group, the holding focuses on project development, investment, and management. While implementing prestigious projects in central and valuable locations in Istanbul under the Polat Real Estate brand, it expands its service network with Polat Management and Piyalepaşa Management companies.

Polat Real Estate stands out in the sector with Piyalepaşa Istanbul Premium, the second phase of "Piyalepaşa Istanbul," Türkiye's largest urban transformation project carried out by the private sector, and the internationally award-winning Polat Levent Exclusive project, which offers a private, luxury living experience.

Polat Real Estate continues its investments in Hungary with APD Real Estate and PD Real Estate. The "City Pearl" project, Hungary's largest urban transformation project, bears the signature of Polat Real Estate. Additionally, the Duna Pearl project, awarded the LEED Certificate, is a mixed-use development combining residential, hotel, and retail spaces, and is among Polat Real Estate's notable projects.

Polat Energy is growing stronger with its investments in wind power plants, solar power plants, and energy storage

Sürdürülebilir bir gelecek inşa etme vizyonuyla With a vision of building a sustainable future, Polat Energy is pioneering projects in the renewable energy sector, continuing its investments in wind and solar power plants both domestically and internationally. Polat Energy, which brought Türkiye its largest wind power plant, Soma WPP, with an installed capacity of 328.9 MW, is also investing in energy storage for this plant. Representing approximately 6% of Türkiye's installed wind energy capacity with a total installed capacity of 806 MW, Polat Energy has prepared the energy storage system (EDS) at Soma WPP, which is integrated with Türkiye's first grid-scale wind power plant, for ministry approval.

At the Geycek power plant, one of Türkiye's largest renewable power plants with 168 MW of wind and 46.6 MW of solar installed capacity, a contract has been signed for Türkiye's first energy storage facility integrated into wind and solar hybrid power plants as part of the storage capacity increase. Furthermore, as part of the capacity increase with storage at Göktepe WPP, a supply agreement was signed with Rolls-Royce Solution GmbH for Türkiye's largest Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) with a capacity of approximately 132 MWh.

Polat Holding has made remarkable progress in the renewable energy sector with sustainable and environmentally conscious solutions in Hungary, where it has continued its investments since 2017. In addition to its energy investments, it successfully pursues its mission of contributing to the local community.

In 2024, Polat Energy signed a letter of intent with ENERCON and İş Enerji in Berlin for new wind energy investments of 2,500 MW. High efficiency is targeted with the new generation E-175 EP5 turbines to be used in this project.

Strategic investment power in technology



The company, which contributes to Türkiye's space technologies, is working on wide-angle camera systems for Türkiye's Moon Mission as part of its collaboration with TÜBİTAK UZAY. Poltech, on the other hand, stands out with its wide range of products and services, offering integrated and end-to-end solutions in the field of high-security document technologies...

Polat Holding continues its operations without compromising on the principles of transparency, high quality, and trust. With 70 years of experience, an innovative vision, and all the companies under its umbrella, Polat Holding aims to create a sustainable future. Polat Holding contributes to employment through its investments in various sectors and is also a major player in global markets through its international partnerships.

A major player in international trade

ALX Polat Foreign Trade, which is part of the holding company and holds a significant position in international trade, continues its operations in Istanbul, Ankara, Izmir, Bursa, and Athens. As the official representative of the Hungarian Export Promotion Agency (HEPA) responsible for Türkiye and Greece, ALX Polat Dış Ticaret plays a key role in strengthening trade relations between these two countries and Hungary.

Between 2016 and 2024, the trade volume between Hungary and Türkiye increased by 66% to \$4.6 billion, while the trade volume between Hungary and Greece increased by over 100% to \$1.1 billion. ALX Polat Foreign Trade is among the organizations that have contributed effectively to this growth. Energy Group

Polat Holding stands out with its investments focused on sustainability and environmental transformation in the energy sector.

Polat Enerji, part of the group, is strengthening its leading position in renewable energy production every day, while also becoming a global energy player with its energy storage technologies and international investments.

Polat Enerji

Established in 2000 to meet Türkiye's sustainable, renewable, and environmentally responsible energy needs, Polat Energy plays a significant role in energy transformation by focusing on the country's highpotential wind and solar energy resources. Providing approximately 6% of Türkiye's installed wind energy capacity, Polat Enerji has a total installed capacity of 806 MW.

Polat Enerji operates five wind power plants in different regions of Türkiye, one of which is a hybrid solar plant.

The company, which has distinguished itself through pioneering projects since its establishment, is now Türkiye's largest wind energy investor in terms of installed capacity. In addition to capacity increases in its current licensed projects, Polat Enerji is also implementing new wind and solar energy investments. With its strategic investments in energy storage systems, it is taking strong steps towards energy continuity, efficiency, and manageability.

Strong Investments in Energy Storage

Committed to reducing its carbon footprint, growing with local resources, and investing in innovative technologies, Polat Enerji steadfastly pursues its vision of leading the energy transition of the future. In line with this vision, Polat Enerji is making strong investments in the field of energy storage. As the holder of the first battery storage license, it is making energy production more balanced, secure, and efficient while continuously increasing its production capacity with wind and solar investments. In this regard, the company has prepared Türkiye's first grid-scale energy storage system, integrated with a wind power plant in Soma, for ministerial approval. The company has also signed a contract for Türkiye's first energy storage facility integrated with wind and solar hybrid power plants as part of the storage capacity increase at the Geycek power plant, one of Türkiye's largest renewable power plants. In addition, Türkiye's largest Battery Energy Storage System supply agreement was signed as part of the storage capacity increase at Göktepe WPP.

Polat Enerji served Türkiye by bringing into service the largest WPP

Commissioned in 2009, Soma WPP is Türkiye's largest operational wind farm and ranks among Europe's top 10 largest wind power plants. Soma WPP was followed by Seyitali WPP in 2011, Poyraz WPP in 2012, and Geycek WPP in 2013, which is Türkiye's fifth largest plant in operation. Following the establishment of Göktepe WPP in 2020, Ege WPP was finally established in 2022.

Polat Enerji Makes a Major Global Leap

Polat Enerji, which has made pioneering investments in the renewable energy sector, has transitioned to a multinational structure by establishing "Polat Energy Europe." Launching its international growth strategy with Polat Energy Europe, established in 2024, the company brought two solar power plants with a total capacity of 86 MWp online in Hungary, increasing its total installed capacity to 300 MW. It has also begun construction preparations for a new 63 MW_p project.

Commissioned in 2013, Geycek Wind Power Plant is Türkiye's fifth largest wind power plant with an installed capacity of 214.6 MW_m / 168 MW_e. Work is ongoing on a 4.2 MW_e and a 46.64 MW_m hybrid solar energy unit to utilize solar energy as an auxiliary source.

Within the scope of Ege WPP's 6 MW $_{\rm e}$ capacity increase investment approved in 2022, the construction and installation process of two turbines was completed at the end of December 2023. They were commissioned in January 2024 with the approval of the Ministry of Energy and Natural Resources.

In addition, the application made to Energy Market Regulatory Authority (EMRA) in 2022 for storage capacity increase was approved in April 2023 as 20 MW_m / 20 MW_h. Project development is ongoing.

Investments in Hungary

Polat Holding has been creating value by producing environmentally friendly energy solutions in Hungary since 2017. Polat Holding's Lumen Park Szolnok investment, completed in 2024, holds the title of "Central and Eastern Europe's largest new generation solar power plant."

Polat Holding has made remarkable progress in Hungary, where it has continued its investments since 2017, with sustainable and environmentally conscious solutions in the renewable energy sector.

One of the most important steps in this context was Lumen Park Szolnok, located in the JászNagykun-Szolnok Region of Hungary. Completed in 2024, this investment stands out as the largest new generation solar power plant in Central and Eastern Europe. The project is notable not only for its scale but also for its innovative and environmentally friendly development approach.

During the project's development process, environmental sensitivity was prioritized through studies focused on creating complex habitats and assessing biological diversity.

Lumen Park Szászberek, another strategic project of Polat Holding, also adds a new dimension to sustainable finance models. Polat Energy will continue to prioritize innovation and sustainable growth in its future strategies.

Polat Holding successfully continues its mission of contributing to the local community in addition to its energy investments. In line with this, in 2024, the company provided support to families in Szászberek for education expenses and contributed to animal protection and education programs in Szolnok where children can learn about renewable energy sources.

With the Gyöngyöshalász power plant becoming operational by the end of 2024, the company aims to increase social benefit through environment and education-focused social projects, in addition to contributing to economic development in the region.

Energy Storage System Agreements

Polat Energy is undertaking significant projects in the field of energy storage to further strengthen its renewable energy investments.



Polat Energy signed Türkiye's largest energy storage system agreement with Rolls-Royce.

Göktepe Rüzgar Enerjisi Santrali'nde depolamalı kapasite artışı kapsamında Rolls-Royce Solution GmbH ile 132 As part of the storage capacity increase at the Göktepe Wind Energy Plant, a supply agreement was signed with Rolls-Royce Solution GmbH for Türkiye's largest Battery Energy Storage System with a capacity of 132 MWh. This project will make wind energy production more efficient and strengthen grid stability. This collaboration will also serve as a strong example of adapting world-class technologies to Türkiye's renewable energy goals.



A letter of intent was signed with ENERCON and İş Enerji at the German-Turkish Energy Forum.

At the German-Turkish Energy Forum held in Berlin in 2024, a letter of intent was signed with ENERCON and İş Enerji for new wind investments totaling 2,500 MW. As part of this collaboration, ENERCON's new generation E-175 EP5 turbines, one of the most efficient turbines in Europe, will be used, with a capacity of 6.0-7.0 MW, aiming to maximize our efficiency in wind energy.



Polat Energy is increasing its renewable power with an integrated hybrid investment in the Kırşehir Geycek power plants.

Following the addition of a 46.6 MW hybrid solar power plant to the Geycek Wind Power Plant as an auxiliary source in 2024 and the increase in installed capacity to 214.6 MWh, Battery Energy Storage Systems are also planned to be commissioned in the near future. Therefore, this investment not only means an increase in installed capacity, but is also considered an important step towards transforming the Geycek Plant into Türkiye's first integrated hybrid energy facility combining grid-scale wind, solar, and storage systems.



An agreement has been reached for the installation of an energy storage unit at Ege WPP.

An agreement has been reached for the installation of a 12.8 MW / 15,176 MW_h capacity energy storage unit at the Ege Wind Energy Plant. This project marks a new era in energy storage infrastructure by combining globally proven battery technology and power conversion systems (PCS) with local Energy Management Systems (EMS) and engineering solutions. The system will enable electricity generated from wind energy to be stored and transferred to the grid when needed, manage production imbalances, and maximize the revenue of the energy storage system through trade optimizations. Thus, while optimizing wind energy production, it will also make a significant contribution to the stability of Türkiye's electricity grid. This project will highlight the importance of Battery Energy Storage Systems in increasing renewable energy capacity.

Housing and Mixed Concept Projects

Piyalepaşa Istanbul, a project that reflects the cultural heritage of Beyoğlu, renowned for its 500-year history, has received numerous national and international awards. Piyalepaşa Istanbul Premium, the second phase of the project, stands out with its high-ceilinged, spacious, and airy apartments, as well as its design that maximizes natural light.

The commercial area of the project, Polat Piyalepaşa Çarşı, was designed as an open-air shopping and lifestyle center in the first phase, with 7 modern art galleries and the 2,500 m² Han Spaces Piyalepaşa office on an area of 22,500 m².

With the completion of the final phase of Piyalepaşa Istanbul, the shopping street will reach a total length of approximately 1 kilometer. 94.8% of the total leasable area in the first phase, i.e., 62 units, has already been leased. Of the 62 leased commercial units, 10 are restaurants, 5 are cafes, and the rest are distinguished product and service brands. With the addition of 14,500 m² of commercial space in the second phase, the total number of commercial units will exceed 100.

Another innovation planned for the second phase of the project is a hotel with 220 rooms under the Courtyard by Marriott brand and 126 rooms under the Residence Inn by Marriott brand.

On the other hand, the new phase of the project, Piyalepaşa Istanbul Premium, will contribute to Istanbul's culture and arts world with an art center that can accommodate approximately 2,000 people and covers 1,000 square meters.

Equipped with the latest technology, this center is planned as a new entertainment and performance center where the most popular local and international shows will be staged. Capable of hosting numerous international shows and concerts, this new performing arts center will be the new meeting point for art lovers in Istanbul.

The Polat Akatlar project, with its 112 apartments, strong structure, and elegant architecture, is a project that will add value to the neighborhood. With its impressive facade, social areas, and design suitable for working from home, it aims to offer an environment compatible with contemporary city life.

Polat Levent Exclusive is being implemented in Levent as a mixed-use project that has won the Good Design Awards. The project, which includes a total of 77 apartments, 9 duplex home offices, and 21 commercial units, is planned as 14 floors and stands out with its 176 m² social area and shared pool on its 250 m² terrace.

We continue to grow with our investments abroad.

Duna Pearl, located on the banks of the Danube River, was developed with an investment of 123 million euros. With its mixed-use structure consisting of 193 residences, a 105-room hotel, and 12 stores, it was selected as the "Real Estate Project of the Year" in 2024.

The first phase of City Pearl, developed with a 683 million Euro investment through a partnership between Nurol and Özaltın Holding, was completed in 2024, with over 300 apartments delivered. The project aims to transform the area into a modern living center with approximately 1,800 residences in 7 blocks and the Grand Piazza open-air shopping area.

Developed in collaboration with Spanish All Iron Rei Socimi in the Elisabethváros district, which is on the UNESCO World Heritage List, Seven Pearl is designed as a mixed-use project with a total of 163 residences and 11 commercial units, representing an investment of 90 million euros. Rising on Dohány Street, one of Budapest's most historic and central locations and also a popular destination for young people, Seven Pearl is Polat's third mixed-use concept project in Hungary.



Located in Piyalepaşa, one of Istanbul's oldest and most valuable neighborhoods, Piyalepaşa Istanbul is being built on 82 acres of land. With its stepped facades, wide eaves, bay windows, pools, and inner courtyard system, it offers a brand-new living space in harmony with the fabric of the city and the neighborhood. Designed to complement the neighborhood's silhouette, Piyalepaşa Istanbul offers a prime location with its proximity to the D-100 Highway and ring road connections, as well as the Dolmabahçe and Kağıthane tunnels.

Piyalepaşa Istanbul, which also bears traces of Seljuk and Ottoman architecture, stands out as one of the first projects in the world and in Türkiye to receive LEED certification from the U.S. Green Building Council at the neighborhood level.

As part of Türkiye's Moon Mission, the navigation and two wide-angle camera systems to be developed in accordance with the contract signed between Poloptech and TÜBİTAK UZAY will make significant contributions to Türkiye's space exploration efforts.

With the wide-angle camera system project, which will be developed to provide detailed, high-resolution imaging of the Moon's surface, Poloptech will advance the future of space exploration together with TÜBİTAK UZAY.







The Story of the Polat Foundation

Established in January 2023 under the leadership of the Polat family, the Polat Foundation aims to support our society through facilities and social assistance in the fields of education, sports, environment, and culture in Türkiye. Through our activities in these areas, we strive to contribute to the development of Turkish citizens as individuals with high cultural and educational standards, committed to the principles of the Republic, and beneficial to the country.

Immediately after its establishment, following the earthquakes centered in Kahramanmaraş in February 2023, the foundation began its work by providing emergency humanitarian aid in the disaster area. From the very first days, it has been active in many areas, from providing generators and tents to technical infrastructure support, from in-kind aid to the establishment of container cities. The delivery of 86 containers in Iskenderun and the establishment of the 123-container Polatköy Settlement in Samandağ were among the important steps taken during this process. In collaboration with the Koruncuk Foundation, girls' access to education was supported, and special support was provided to Polat employees' relatives affected by the disaster. In 2023, the Suna Polat Youth Center, opened in collaboration with the Samandağ Municipality and with a capacity of 350 people, contributed to the reconstruction of social life in the region.





In 2024, the Polat Foundation expanded its field of activity by focusing on social benefit projects related to education and the environment, as well as strengthening the culture of solidarity after the disaster. The April 23 and October 29 celebrations organized in Hatay in collaboration with the Feyziye Schools Foundation Işık Schools created moments of hope and joy for children affected by the earthquake. These events, held at different locations in Hatay, spread the festive spirit throughout the region with sports activities, cultural performances, and gift distributions.

The "Green Light for the Future" project, one of the sustainability-based projects, was implemented in seven different provinces of Türkiye in 2024, reaching nearly 3,000 students and 500 teachers. These activities, focusing on renewable energy, climate change, and environmental awareness, were carried out through comprehensive educational modules targeting both elementary school students and vocational high school youth.

A social interaction project centered on sports was implemented by hosting students from Galatasaray Nusaybin Sports Schools in Istanbul; this process contributed to the students' personal development and motivation. At the same time, preparatory work for the sports complex planned for Nusaybin was completed, and the first steps were taken towards the construction of a permanent and inclusive culture and sports center.

Just before the new year, in collaboration with the Feyziye Schools Foundation, New Year's events and support organizations were held for children and families in the container cities in Hatay, Antakya, Defne, Harbiye, and Samandağ.

Through all these activities, the Polat Foundation continues to contribute to society with a vision of creating lasting social impact, not only in times of need. Thanks to corporate partnerships and locally driven initiatives, creating sustainable impact in disadvantaged areas has been adopted as a fundamental principle.

This day, filled with fun workshops, games, musical performances, and gifts for the children, brought smiles back to their faces.

In line with the FMV collaboration, shopping cards were delivered to approximately 500 households living in the container cities of Antakya Pınarbaşı, Defne Metin Hatunoğlu, Harbiye Nehir, Harbiye Şelale, Samandağ Polatköy, and the Turkish Football Federation (TFF).

This support aimed to enable families to start the new year with more morale and hope at the end of the first year following the destruction. Launched in 2023 in collaboration with Polat Energy and the Polat Foundation, the "Geleceğe Yeşil Işık Yak" project aims to raise awareness among students and teachers about renewable energy, sustainability, and climate change in line with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals.

Reached 7 Provinces, 3,000 Students, and 500 Teachers in 2024: The project was implemented in 2024 in the provinces of Kırşehir, Manisa, Balıkesir, Yalova, Niğde, Nevşehir, and İzmir, directly reaching a total of 3,000 students and 500 teachers.

Within the scope of the Energy Workshops, carried out with the contribution of Provincial Directorates of National Education, elementary school 3rd and 4th grade students explored basic concepts such as wind energy, sustainability, and carbon footprint through interactive activities. Through group work, students experienced renewable energy systems firsthand by building wind turbine models.
